OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub : Grant of Dearness Relief to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of the Institute-Revised rate effective from 01 January 2024

A reference is being invited to this Office Memorandum No.C 100/RBC dated 07 November 2023 on the subject mentioned above. Pursuant to the decision of the Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare, vide their O.M. No.42/02/2024-P&PW (D) dated 13 March 2024 as well as Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, vide its O.M. No.I-12011/17/2016-ISI (Part-I) dated 22 October 2018 & O.M. No.I-12011/17/2016-ISI (Part-I) dated 09 October 2018, as resolved by the Council of the Institute in its meeting held on 10 October 2018, the rate of Dearness Relief (DR) payable to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of the Institute shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 46% to 50% of the basic pension/family pension (including additional pension/family pension) with effect from 01 January 2024.

2. Payment of DR involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
3. Other provisions governing grant of DR in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in Rule 52 of CCS(Pension) Rules, 2021 and Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare's O.M. No.45/73/97-P & PW (G) dated 2.7.1999 as amended from time to time and in Institute O.M. No.C1118/RBC dated 26 July 2001 and further to Institute O.M. No.C1529/RBC dated 13 November 2009 as amended vide Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare's O.M. F.No.38/88/2008-P & PW (G), dated 09 July 2009. The provisions relating to regulation of DR where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.
4. All Disbursing Authorities should ensure to arrange payment of relief to the pensioners/family pensioners of the Institute on the basis of this O.M.
